### **RCM Report to the Area Service Committee Meeting,**

**June 28, 2009**

The C & P Regional Service Committee met on June 13, 2009 in Rockville, Maryland.

There were two motions that constituted old business. The first: “Policy #46:09:09 (August 1990) To ask that no more special interest meetings be put on the program of the CPRCNA, *i.e.*: men, women, gay,” failed because it did not have the required two-thirds majority of groups voting in favor. The second motion: “To approve the revised Convention Procedures policy to replace the previous revision,” passed.

In new business, there were three motions. The first: to increase the budget for the Literature Subcommittee to fund the Living Clean Project workshops. This motion was referred to the RSC Subcommittee, specifically to the treasurer. Second: nominate Jimi S. as a candidate to the World Board. This motion passed. The third motion: CPRCNA will direct the Policy Subcommittee and/or create an Ad Hoc Committee to create a new Regional Policy. This motion was tabled, and may be ruled out of order.

Nominations for RSC positions for the 2009-2010 service year are listed on Regional Minutes, which I have submitted electronically to the Secretary. We will need groups to vote on these nominations before the next RSC, which is Saturday, August 8<sup>th</sup>, hosted by NORVANA at the Franconia United Methodist Church in Alexandria.
