Step of the Month

Step 5: Admitted to God, to ourselves, and to another human being the exact nature of our wrongs

After finishing my written inventory in Step 4, it was time to proceed without delay to Step 5. I had to let go of any of my fears about sharing intimate details about my past with my sponsor, whom I asked to listen to my Fifth Step.

Tradition 5: Each group has but one primary purpose—to carry the message to the addict who still suffers

Our primary purpose as individuals is to stay clean and help others, whereas the primary purpose of the group is to carry the message of hope to anyone who still suffers.

"The Five Minute Rule"

I realized early in my recovery that I couldn't stand people who shared too long at meetings. I was told that if I found something that really bothered me about someone, I should take a good look at myself, and I might find that character trait in me. Low and behold, there it was! I realized I would share too much, hoping something I would say would sound funny, profound, or at least memorable. I would sit there in meetings, just waiting for you to stop talking because what I had to say was far more important.

So, I decided to change. In changing, I developed what I call "The Five Minute Rule". "The Five Minute Rule" allows me five minutes to share at any meeting I choose to. Before I start to share, I look at the clock and note what time I start sharing. By giving myself a specific amount of time (five minutes), I don't bore the group with the trivial stuff that has happened in my life since the last time I shared. I don't need to rehash stories about "how it was" to people who have heard my story over and over again. I try to get right to the point, telling people what's going on with me, and I move on.

When a person shares more than five minutes, people tend to lose interest, and the person who is sharing is basically talking to themselves. I would rather get to the point right away and have people hear what I'm saying rather than having them sit there with glazed eyes, waiting (praying) for me to shut up. I feel sharing in this manner shows respect to the members and the group as a whole; it allows more time at the meetings for everyone else to share.


