Tradition 11: “Our public relations policy is based on attraction rather than promotion; we need always maintain personal anonymity at the level of press, radio, and films.”

Celebrities will sometimes publicly reveal their membership in a 12-Step program as they get clean. One might think that this is a great way to let the public know about recovery programs. What is better than having someone famous that everybody can recognize and promote the program? Upon further review, we can see how dangerous such a breach of anonymity could be. Such revelations are clearly a violation of Tradition 11. Suppose that a celebrity relapses or does not conduct themselves properly. The public might conclude that 12-Step programs failed. The truth is that it was the celebrity that failed, not the program. ~ Ben C.
