



Step of the Month

Step 3: "We made a decision to turn our will and our lives over to the care of God as we understood Him."

Tradition of the Month

Tradition 3: "The only requirement for membership is a desire to stop using."

This requirement is unconditional without any catches. Identity and membership are the principles of the Third Tradition; you are a member when you say you are, period. You do not have to have a sponsor, do the 12 Steps, believe in a Higher Power, or follow any other suggestions. Having a desire to stop using begins your membership. Even if unsuccessful, members are strongly encouraged to keep coming back and keep trying. Many of us tried and failed several times before recovery really began to stick. Open-mindedness, willingness, faith, and courage in our ability to love and carry the message to everyone is the basis of the Third Tradition.
